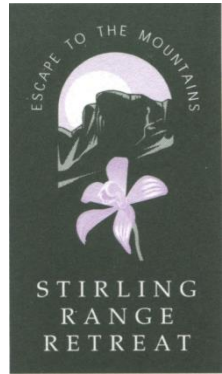

Hidden Treasures Dawn and Dusk Bird Walks

Led by BirdLife volunteer guides.

Daily 8am and 3pm from Retreat office.

Dates: from the last Saturday in August to the last Saturday in October.

Cost: \$20 per person. Duration: 1.5 hours. Terrain: Flat.

Trails: Designated single file trails or well pounded kangaroo trails are followed to minimise damage to habitat.

Recommended clothes: layers, including weatherproof jacket, strong shoes with non-slip soles, long trousers, long sleeved shirt and hat.

Consider bringing: camera, binoculars & pen.

Forward bookings are recommended.
