Participants' Requirements

- Your boat must be under 11m in length and be able to safely navigate under the bridges of the rivers as per page 3.
- Your boat must have a safe, with a reliable power unit
- Your boat must have insurance cover
Please note that although escort vessels form part of each convoy and will do their best to give necessary assistance, in the event of mechanical problems, it is your responsibility to arrange transport back to your departure point..
- Your boat must have a current Boat Registration Sticker
- Your boat must carry a VHF Marine Radio
- Your boat must have on board Full Regulation Safety Equipment. Refer to the website for further information on safety requirements: www.transport.wa.gov.au
